- Founded in October 2002, we help over 700 needy, grieving, homeless, and hospitalized children per year referred to us by nurses, social workers and teachers.
- Our largest fundraiser is a Wine Tasting and Silent Auction every year.
- Kylee was 23 months old when she died. Her twin brother Kevin is now 13 years old. Our charity provides new clothes, new toys, and special wishes for children 0 to 18 years old.
- We are *all-volunteer* and a *year-round organization*.
- We have an annual Holiday Giving Tree in November and December and local schools, churches and businesses host Giving Trees where you can adopt a child's wish by picking an ornament off a tree, buying and returning the gift. Local businesses also host New Toy Drives.
- Types of children we've helped include:
 - children in hospice who are dying and would like a special wish
 - children who have had a parent or brother or sister pass away
 - needy children that need new clothes and necessities
 - hospitalized children and babies that need items before they can come home from the hospital
